

### **Information and Entry Form**

# South Coast NRM invite the South Coast community to enter artwork that celebrate our unique threatened species!

#### **Categories**

There are two categories available for entry:

- 1. Colouring in Competition; colour any of our four colouring sheets and answer the questions on the back of the colouring-in sheet.
  - Age categories for judging: Under 6, 6-8 and 9-12.
  - Both sides must be completed to be eligible for a prize (colouring in page and reverse page).
- 2. Original Artwork; artwork of any medium that celebrates the threatened species of the South Coast Region.
  - Age categories for judging: Under 6, 6-12, 13-17 and open.
  - Entries for this category must be clearly named and dated.

#### **Prizes and Submission**

- For each age bracket in each category, there will be a winner and runner-up awarded, plus a single prize of 'best entry in show'. Prizes for under 12 years will be to the value of \$50 for first prize and \$25 for runner up. Prizes for 13-17 years will be to the value of \$100 for first prize and \$50 for runner up. Prizes for open submissions will be to the value of \$150 for first prize and \$75 for runner up.
- All entries must be accompanied by this entry form.

- Entries to be submitted to South Coast NRM by 4pm on Friday 23rd May 2025. Late submissions will not be accepted. Please allow enough time for posted entries to reach South Coast NRM by the 23rd May.
- · High resolution JPEG images of artwork will be accepted for the original artwork category and colouring in category.
- Submitted originals of artworks and colouring in sheets can be collected from the South Coast NRM office after judging has been completed.

- Winners will be announced at our Artwork Exhibition Event held in Albany on the 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

## **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. The competition is open to all artists who reside in the South Coast NRM region (see https://southcoastnrm.com.au/our-region/ for map). This includes the shires of Esperance, Ravensthorpe, Jerramungup, Gnowangerup, Broomehill/Tambellup, Cranbrook, Mt Barker, Denmark, Walpole and the City of Albany.
- 2. The main species (plant or animal) depicted in the entry must be listed as Threatened (Conservation Dependent, Vulnerable, Endangered, Critically Endangered, or Extinct) under the EPBC Act. To check whether your chosen species is listed as threatened, type it in the search bar on this website: http://www.environment.gov.au/cgibin/sprat/public/sprat.pl. Note that if the species you search for does not return a result, then it is not listed as Threatened under the EPBC Act.
- 3. Entries must showcase a threatened species (plant or animal) found within the South Coast Region (currently or historically).
- 4. A maximum of five (5) entries across all categories, per person is permitted. Entrants are free to choose which categories they enter.
- 5. Entries must have been created within the South Coast NRM region.
- 6. Entries must be the original works of the entrant.
- 7. Entries must be no more than four years old.

- 8. Entries must not have been used for commercial purposes.
- 9. Emailed entries must be in JPEG format and not exceed 20MB in size.
- 10. The judges will be solely responsible for selecting the winning entries for all awards.
- 11. The judges may reject any entry that does not comply with the Conditions of Entry.
- 12. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence in this regard will be entered into.
- 13. Any cost associated with the submission of their entry is the responsibility of the entrant.
- 14. The entrant will retain ownership of any artwork submitted. South Coast NRM reserves the right to use or reproduce any submission in future media, advertising, educational materials or displays without any impediment or seeking permission from the entrant. The entrant will be credited for any use of their work.
- 15. Entry into the competition is free. Parental, guardian or schoolteacher permission will be required for entrants under the age of 18.
- 16. All entries must have the entrant's full name, age, current contact details, date of submission and have been signed by the entrant or guardian.
- 17. No employee or board member of South Coast NRM may win prizes in the competition.
- 18. By signing this entry form and entering the competition, you accept all Conditions of Entry.
